Dr. Stonell is a specialist anaesthetist at The Prince Charles Hospital in Brisbane, where he is a Deputy Director of the Department of Anaesthesia and Perfusion Services (part of Metro North Health). He has a particular clinical interest in cardiac anaesthesia. He provides anaesthesia for a range of cardiac surgical procedures including thoracic organ transplant and mechanical circulatory support.
